### CHURCH AND CAMPUS RENEWAL

Our remodeling is well underway and on schedule to be complete by April 11th. As it goes with any large remodeling project, you hope for the best and plan for the worst. We have had both good news and bad news as we have basically taken our Church down to its four walls and started the rebuilding process (pictures are posted outside the hall entrance).

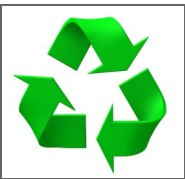
The good news is that we were able to get our flooring for less than our original estimate. This allowed us to make the decision to move forward with expanding our choir area and creating a choir alcove so we could save on re-work to the flooring and paint later. Additionally, we have found items such as larger drip pans for the air conditioning units, ceiling fans, energy efficient lighting, and ceiling tiles that we need to address prior to installation of pews while we have easier access to the ceiling area. **Therefore, we will be moving forward with these items at an additional cost over the original \$110,000 budget.** We have made these decisions because it will improve our worship space and save us money in the long run by not having pews removed and reinstalled to fix these items.

Therefore, we are asking that you continue giving to the renewal fund to help offset the additional cost and we thank you again for all your continued support to improving our worship environment.

## DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

APRIL 27, 2014

### WHO was Sister Faustina, What is Divine Mercy, and Why Should I Care?

Part 2 of a 4 Part Series

There are so many references to God's mercy in the bible, that it would take pages and pages to enumerate them. But the message of mercy, both God's towards us, and ours towards our fellow man is critical to our salvation. In seeking God's mercy, first we must acknowledge that we are sinners. Jesus bought the Father's limitless mercy for us with His life. God's mercy is just sitting there waiting for us, and all we need to do is ask.

Consider the Our Father, the Lord's Prayer. We say it all the time, but do we hear the words we are saying? "...and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us." Jesus gave us this prayer, so it follows that all parts of it are important. It is a template for our lives. We are to ask for God's mercy, and we are to show mercy to others. In grade school we learned the Beatitudes from the Sermon on the Mount. "Blessed are the merciful for they shall be shown mercy."

The history of the Jewish people in the Old Testament is the convincing proof of God's mercy. They turned from Him repeatedly, but when they cried out to Him, He forgave and rescued them. Then as the greatest manifestation of His mercy, He sent Jesus to His people, and ultimately, to the world.

In the bible, the definition of mercy is "A radiation of God's love which takes into consideration the weakness of His creatures." Consider entry 1074 from Sister Faustina's diary. "**When a soul approaches Me (Jesus) with trust, I fill it with such an abundance of graces that it cannot contain them within itself, but radiates them to other souls.**"

The ABC's of Mercy:

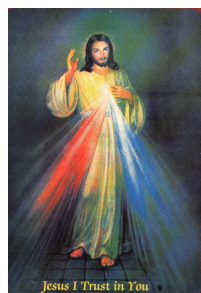
**A**sk for His mercy. "Ask and it will be given to you...for everyone who asks, receives" (Mt 7:7,8)

**B**e merciful to others. "Be merciful even as your Father is merciful" (Lk 6:36)

**C**ompletely trust in Jesus. "I have opened My Heart as a living fountain of mercy. Let all souls draw life from it. Let them approach this sea of mercy with trust." (Diary 1520)

"Come then with trust to draw graces from this fountain. I never reject a contrite heart." (Diary 1485)

"Mankind will not have peace until it turns with trust to My mercy." (Diary 300).
