

Children will not be allowed to go to the bathroom by themselves. Small children and young teens need to be supervised, in case of an emergency, Security will be busy securing doors or evacuating people.



Although we will celebrate Ugandan Martyrs' Day – Feast of St. Charles Lwanga and Companions, Martyrs -- on June 23rd, its actual feast day falls on June 3rd. In Uganda, an estimated 1.3 million individuals are anticipated to journey to the Martyrs' Shrine in Namugongo, with many embarking on foot as part of a pilgrimage. Notably, over 1,500 pilgrims, including seven (7) from the **Zeu Catholic Parish** (this is the Parish of the School we assisted with our Lenten Project this year) – **Beatrice, Alex, Alice, Sophia, Robert, Joyce, and William** – commenced their nearly 300-mile trek on May 14th. Thankfully, all members from Zeu are in good health and spirits on their pilgrimage. Let's keep them, along with all visitors to the shrine, in our prayers during this significant celebration. This year's festivities, organized by the Nebbi Catholic Diocese, will revolve around the theme "But as for me and my household, we shall serve the Lord," inspired by Joshua 24:15.
